SHARE THESE TIPS WITH YOUR  
LOVED ONES.

baby getting sick.

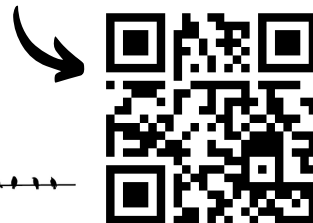
The Cuckoo
