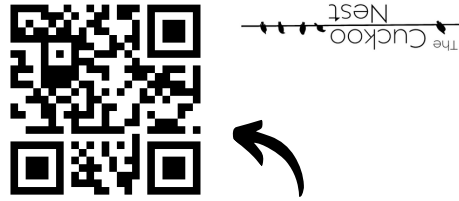

Nest

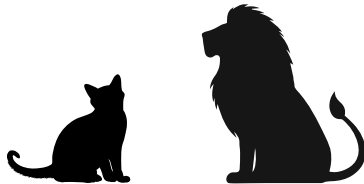

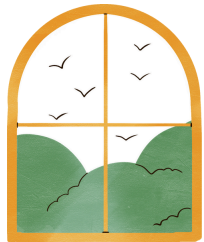
Sick cows, cow poop, and
